Durbar with chiefs, queen mothers and other community leaders to address child marriage; TV and live radio shows; Training Victims in various trades to empower them.



COVID-19 Pandemic brought with it a lot of surprises that overwhelmed the whole world. Luckily for Ghana the effect was not too devastating as experienced elsewhere.

Nevertheless, there was the need to take necessary action to protect our own. Following from this, Rescue Volunteers Ghana went on a nationwide campaign in 2020-2021 to demonstrate and distribute PPEs to sellers and buyers at major markets in the country for the first phase of the campaign.

The second phase targeted student representatives and their facilitators for onward demonstration and distribution of PPEs to the needy in their various schools. This is to ensure that the most vulnerable remain safe.






